In the wake of the recent Los Angeles fires, we asked ourselves: What do we have in the house?

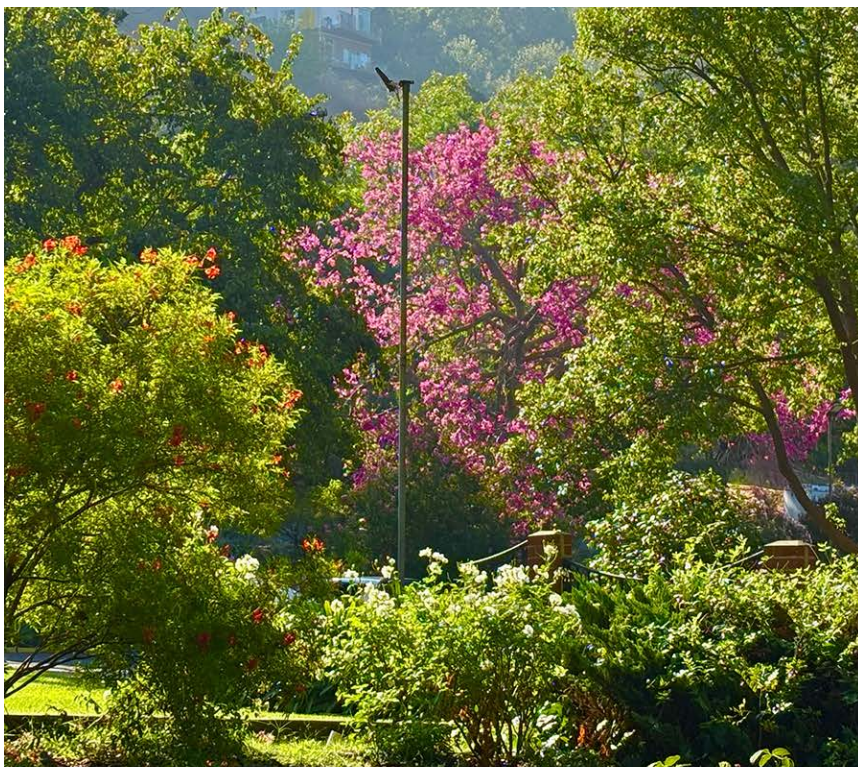
